- Label items such as jackets, sweaters and PE uniform

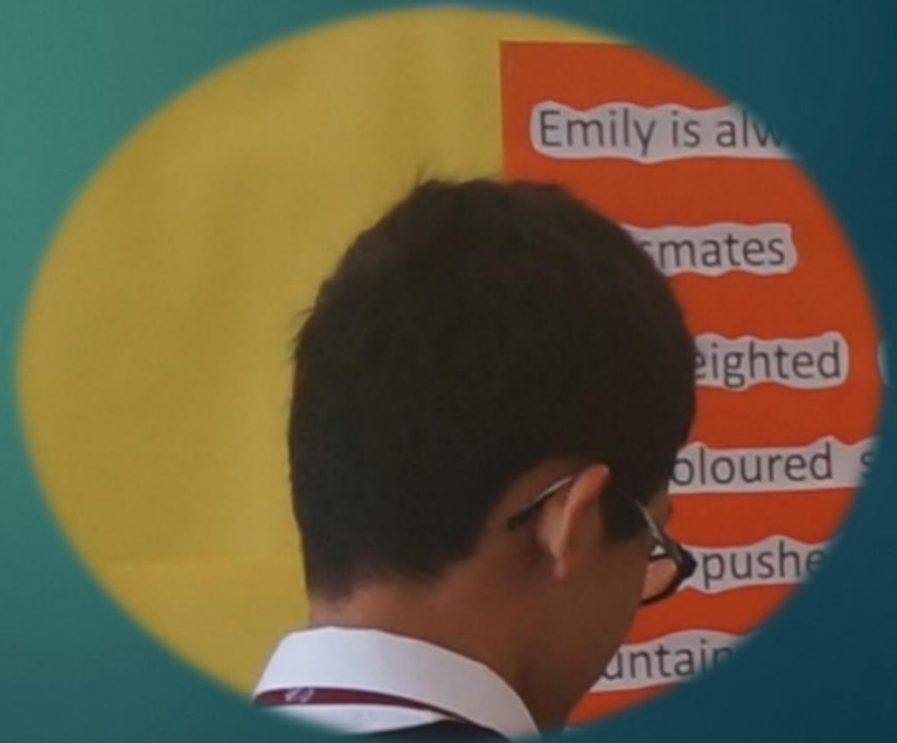
# HAIR

- Girls: Hair should be tied up (long hair)



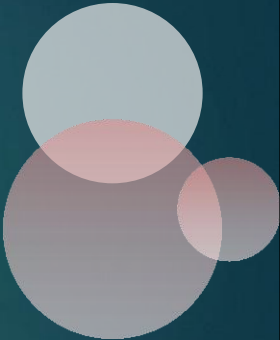

- υ Black leather shoes
- υ Black and / or white sports shoes
- υ Plain, white socks (2 inches above the ankles)
- υ Shoe liners are NOT permitted.

# JEWELLERY

- u Simple watch
- u Earrings for girls only – one pair of plain stud earrings or small hoop earrings.
- u Piercings are not permitted.
- u Bangles for Sikh students only
- u Other jewellery will be confiscated and returned to student via parent / guardian



# PERSONAL BELONGINGS



- u You are responsible for safeguarding your personal belongings. **DO NOT** leave them unattended.
- u **DO NOT** bring a lot of money to school.
- u **DO NOT** bring valuable items to school.
- u The school will not be responsible for any loss or theft.
- u Electronic games, non-educational related items are prohibited. **DO NOT** bring them to school.
- u Failure to comply with this: item will be confiscated and kept by the school until collected by parent/guardian. Student will face disciplinary action.

# MOBILE PHONES



- Any parent wants their child to bring mobile phone back to school must seek approval from the school authority by completing an agreement in the student handbook.
- Students who bring mobile phones to school do so at their own risk. The school will not be responsible for any loss or theft.

# MOBILE PHONES

- MOBILE PHONES MUST BE SWITCHED OFF AT ALL TIMES AT SCHOOL.
- Failure to comply: mobile phone will be confiscated and kept by the school for **2 week or until collected by parent/guardian.** A black mark will be issued to the student.
