- ▶ Label items such as jackets, sweaters and PE uniform

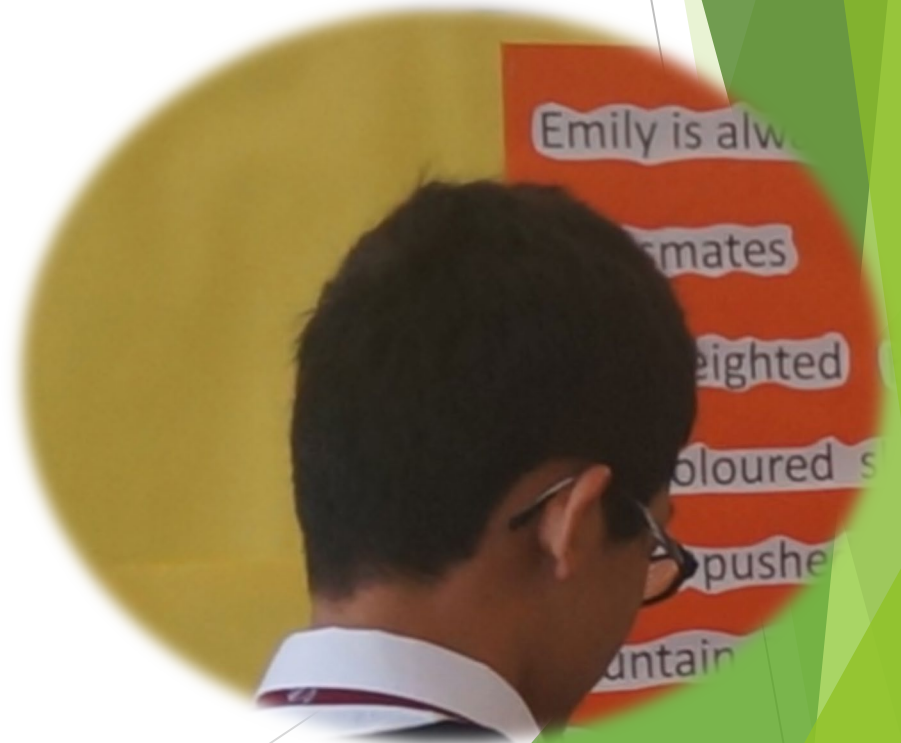
# Hair

- ▶ Natural hair colour
- ▶ Simple, tidy hair cut
- ▶ No hair gel or similar products
- ▶ Boys: Hair should not cover the ears and eyes, and should not touch the collar
- ▶ Girls: Long hair should be tied up

# Trousers

- ▶ Navy blue straight leg trousers of the right size and length  
(Purchase from authorized uniform shop)



# Dress Length

- ▶ The hem of the dress must fall at the top of the knee cap, or below

# Shoes and Socks

- ▶ Black leather shoes
- ▶ Black and / or white sports shoes of a simple design
- ▶ Plain, white socks (2 inches above the ankles)
- ▶ Shoe liners are NOT permitted.

# School Tracksuit

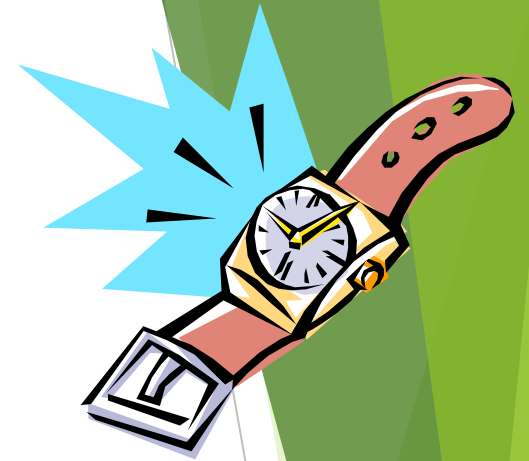
- ▶ **All students are required to have a complete school tracksuit.**

(Can be purchased from authorized uniform shop)



# Jewellery

- ▶ Simple watch
- ▶ Earrings for girls only – one pair of plain stud earrings or small hoop earrings.
- ▶ Other piercings are NOT permitted.
- ▶ Bangles for Sikh students only
- ▶ Other jewellery will be confiscated and returned to student via parent or guardian



# Personal Belongings

- ▶ Students are responsible for safeguarding their personal belongings. **DO NOT** leave them unattended.
- ▶ **DO NOT** bring a lot of money to school.
- ▶ **DO NOT** bring valuable items to school.
- ▶ The school will not be responsible for any loss or theft.
- ▶ Electronic games, non-educational related items are prohibited. **DO NOT** bring them to school.
- ▶ Failure to comply with this: Item will be confiscated and kept by the school until collected by parent or guardian. The student will face disciplinary action.

# Mobile Phones

- ▶ Any parent who wants their child to bring a mobile phone to school must seek approval from the school authority by completing an agreement in the student handbook.
- ▶ Students who bring mobile phones to school do so at their own risk. The school will not be responsible for any loss or theft.

# MOBILE PHONES

**MUST BE SWITCHED OFF  
AT ALL TIMES AT SCHOOL**

- ▶ Failure to comply: Mobile phone will be confiscated and kept by the school for **2 weeks or until collected by parent or guardian**
- ▶ A black mark will be issued to the student.

# Behaviour Inside and Outside School

- ▶ At school, show respect, courtesy and consideration to others.
- ▶ In public, behave courteously and considerately.
- ▶ Students are ambassadors for the school and for their communities.
- ▶ Respect others, respect yourselves.
