Jewellery

- Simple watch
- Earrings for girls only one pair of plain stud earrings or small hoop earrings.
- ▶ Other piercings are NOT permitted.
- Bangles for Sikh students only
- Other jewellery will be confiscated and returned to student via parent or guardian



Personal Belongings

- Students are responsible for safeguarding their personal belongings. DO NOT leave them unattended.
- **DO NOT** bring a lot of money to school.
- **DO NOT** bring valuable items to school.
- ► The school will not be responsible for any loss or theft.
- Electronic games, non-educational related items are prohibited. DO NOT bring them to school.
- Failure to comply with this: Item will be confiscated and kept by the school until collected by parent or guardian. The student will face disciplinary action.

Mobile Phones

- Any parent who wants their child to bring a mobile phone to school must seek approval from the school authority by completing an agreement in the student handbook.
- Students who bring mobile phones to school do so at their own risk. The school will not be responsible for any loss or theft.

MOBILE PHONES

- ► Failure to comply: Mobile phone will be confiscated and kept by the school for 2 weeks or until collected by parent or guardian
- A black mark will be issued to the student.
