The winning work was displayed for all students in the school to know some of the excellent achievements of our Country.
	2 <sup>nd</sup> term	Cheung Chau Cultural Visit was organized for selected S4 and S5 students	\$1,362.4	Guided field trip to Cheung Chau was provided by Caritas Chan Chun Ha Field Study Centre to explore the traditional Chinese architecture and values. A total of 26 students participated and all of them enjoyed the programme and agreed the tour achieved its objectives.
	2 <sup>nd</sup> term	Local Tour on Chinese Culture for all S.4 and selected S.5	\$18,445	A guided tour visit Teo Chew Cultural Association, “Dried Seafood Street” and Herbal Garden was organized for students to understand the making of traditional Chinese festive food, close relationship between the mainland and Hong Kong in terms of trading of dried seafood and rice and the use of Chinese medicines. A total of 73 students participated, over 85%

				of students agreed that the trip was interesting and learned new knowledge about different Chinese culture.

The expenses were used for deploying travel agency to process bulk application of China Visa.  The service was very important and enhance the efficiency of Visa application.
Subsidize students to participate joint-school / cross-curricular activities or competition relating to CS curriculum held in HK or in the Mainland	Throughout the year	6 students participated in a Guided Tour Competition	0	A group of 6 students participated in Joint-government school guided tour competition. They designed a trip bringing some S.1 students in Yuen Long Public School to tour around Yau Tsim Mong to explorer the multi-culture in HK.
