Develop CS curriculum suitable for the needs of our students	Throughout the year	Develop or procure relevant learning and teaching resources, reference materials for CS	HK\$ 53,320	VR tours for different locations in Hong Kong and Foshan from the mainland were purchased. These tours offer a transformative approach to learning about society and culture. By immersing students in realistic environments, VR enhances engagement and retention of information. The tours are accessible, allowing students to visit places they may never physically reach, thus broadening their horizons. Banners regarding the Celebration of the 75th anniversary of the founding of the People's Republic of China were made and hanged all over the campus. This created a visually stimulating environment, and served as constant reminders of the establishment of People's Republic of China.
Provide learning experience to students	2 nd term	Organizing school-based learning activities relating to the CS curriculum	HK\$ 22,496	The CS local cultural tour to the Mills in Tsuen Wan and the activity of making the 'Peace bun' effectively engaged S4 students in Chinese culture. By participating in traditional food-making, students gained hands-on experience and a deeper appreciation for cultural practices. The immersive nature of the tour fostered curiosity and enhanced understanding, making it a valuable educational experience.
	2 nd term	Subsidizing students and teachers to participate in Mainland interflow activities or study tour relating to the CS curriculum	HK\$ 12,000	The S5 CS Mainland Study Tour would be held between 13 and 14 February 2025. The tour would be fully subsidized by the EDB. The CS grant was used to subsidize 27 students to apply for single-entry visa to the Mainland. Most of the subsidized students had never been to the Mainland before. The tour enhances students' understanding of Mainland culture, fostering

				international awareness and enriching their educational experience through first-hand exploration.
Develop students' potential	Throughout the year	Subsidize students to participate joint-school / cross-curricular activities or competition relating to CS curriculum held in HK or in the Mainland	HK\$ 2,200	Coaches were arranged for students to participate in activities or competition relating to CS curriculum, for example, students were arranged to visit the National Security Exhibition Gallery. These activities effectively enhances collaboration and knowledge sharing. These opportunities foster teamwork and critical thinking, while exposing students to diverse perspectives. Participation in competitions further motivates students to apply their skills, enriching their overall educational experience.
