Please be informed of the following matters:

1. <u>School Picnic</u>

This year's school picnic will be held on <u>7 November 2018</u> (Wednesday). Details of the activity are as follows:

Coaches will be arranged to take students both to the picnic site and back to school. A transportation fee of \$40 will be collected. The remaining transportation cost will be subsidized by the school. Students are required to wear their P.E. uniform, tracksuit and sports shoes. Long trousers in black, dark/navy blue are accepted. They should prepare their own lunch.

Please be informed that the School Picnic is an important school function in which all students must take part. All students must arrive at school on that day before 8:15 am. Coaches will depart at 8:30 am. Students who do not participate in this activity for health reasons must stay at school under normal school hours. Some assignments will be arranged for them to work on under the supervision of teachers.

2. <u>Matters concerning School Uniforms</u>

A. <u>Winter School Uniform</u>

With effect from Monday, <u>12 November 2018</u>, students may opt to wear winter uniform. From Monday, <u>26 November 2018</u>, it will be compulsory for all students to wear winter uniform.

Please note that sweaters should be navy blue V-neck with the school logo and jackets should be navy blue fleece jackets with the school badge. Boys must wear plain black belts with simple buckles. For girls admitted in or after 2016/17 academic year, the new pale blue, cotton blend pin striped blouse should be worn.

B. <u>New arrangement of non-uniform jackets during winter</u>

When the *Cold Weather Warning* is issued, plain navy blue, dark blue or black jackets may be worn on top of the school sweater or school jacket if necessary. Please be reminded that denim jackets, leather jackets and pullover sweaters are not permitted.

C. <u>New arrangement of PE uniform</u>

For the sake of personal hygiene and to provide a pleasant learning environment to our students, PE uniform can only be worn *during PE lessons*. Students have to wear proper school uniform at other times. Students must bring their house T-shirt, school PE cotton shorts/ pants or school track pants for their PE lessons.

For details of the uniform regulations, please refer to the school uniform regulations on pages 3 & 4 of the student's handbook.

3. <u>Special Timetable</u>

As indicated in the school calendar 2018/2019, 12 November 2018, 19 February 2019 and 10 April 2019 are stipulated for "*Collaborative Lesson Preparation and Teachers' Sharing on Teaching Strategies*". 5. **SBA Notice Regarding S5 and S6 Students**

甲、 更換冬季校服
