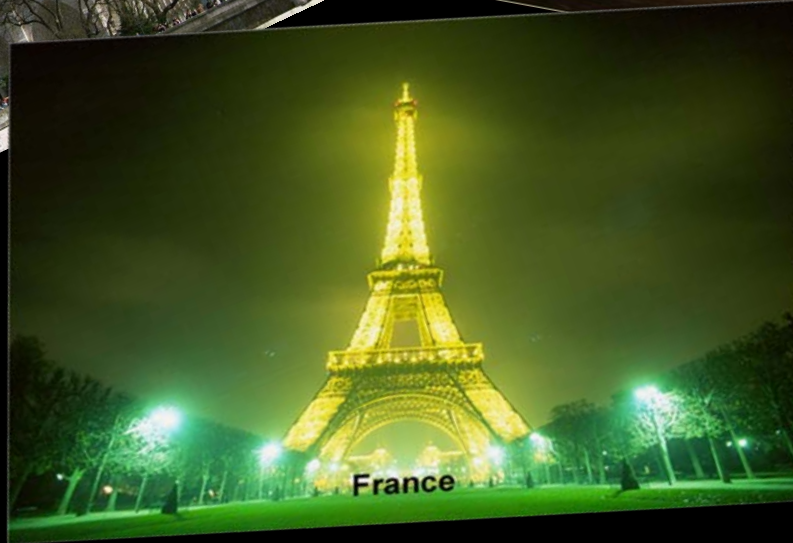

PLACE VENDÔME
 Superb and austere at the same time, this square, inaugurated in 1699 and built in the shape of a rectangle with its corners cut off, was originally a virtually enclosed space measuring 160 by 50 yds. Behind the uniform 80-ft high walls are hidden magnificent townhouses, one of which is the Hotel Ritz.

 In 1764, Constant d'Orly, commissioned by Louis XVI to build a church, came up with a design based on a Greek temple, similar to that of the National

dedicated to religion.

Place Vendôme (8 D1)
 ➤ Superb and austere at the same time, this square, inaugurated in 1699 and built in the shape of a rectangle with its corners cut off, was originally a virtually enclosed space measuring 160 by 50 yds. Behind the uniform 80-ft

was designed for Louis XVI in 1764. Contrary to other great squares it is only walled on one side in order to maintain the perspective of the triumphal axis; to the east are the Tuileries and the Louvre palace; to the west, the Champs-Élysées. The Louvre obelisk, presented by the victory of Egypt, was erected in the

exhibitions since the early 1930s. Magnificently restored, it reopened in 1993 and now mounts temporary exhibitions of contemporary art. Next door, the Dragagee used to reopen in August after autumn installation work; houses Matar's famous table of paintings Les Aborigènes.

and opened up the view to the west with a road which later became the Champs-Élysées. The octagonal lake, the terraces running along the Seine and the Rue de Rivoli, the numerous Champs and five trees growing on either side of the central avenue all convey the romance of times past.

Mediterranean basin to the first half of the 19th century, today completed by a new section on primitive arts. Over 800 years of French history are contained within these walls. 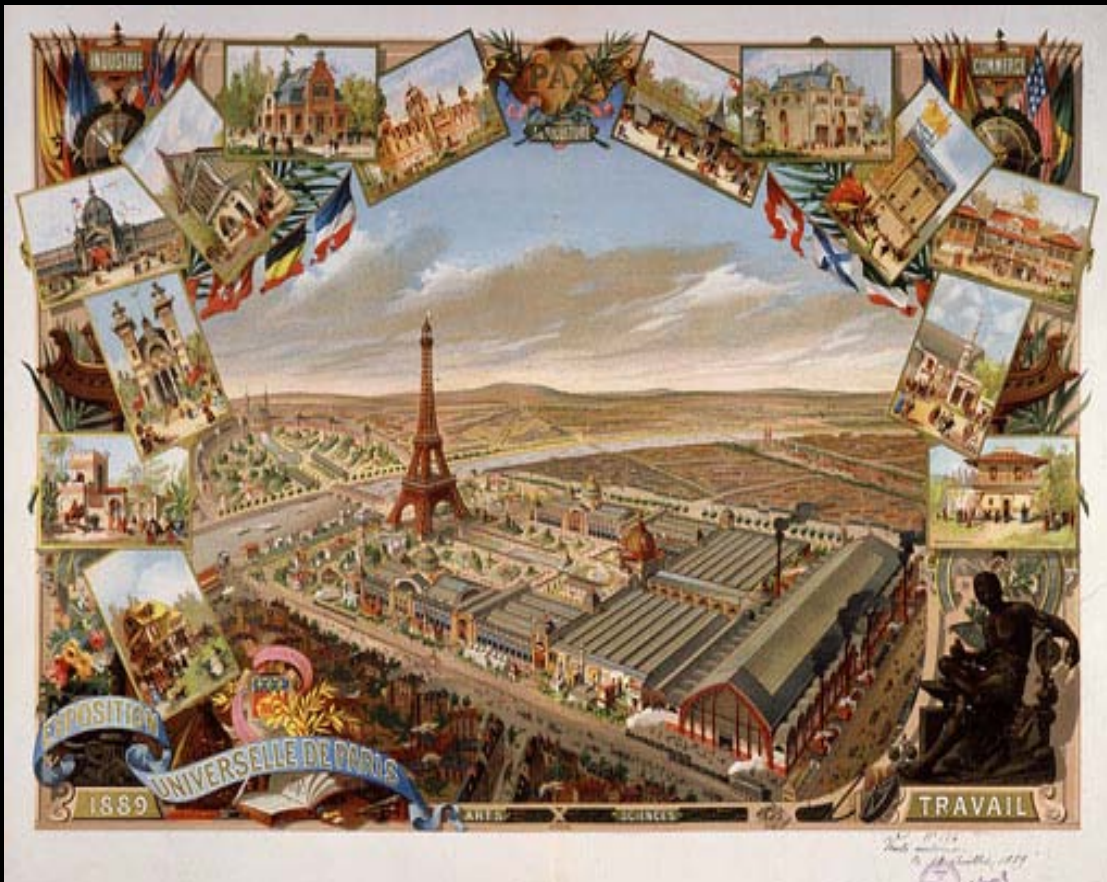
