

Name of Play: The magic spell

Characters: Princess, Prince, Witch and the God

Scene: In the palace

Setting: In the palace, long time ago

Narrator's Introduction:

Once upon a time, there was a beautiful princess and a handsome prince. They loved each other very much. So, they were going to get married.

The prince: I love you! (Going to slip the ring in the princess's finger.)

The princess: I love you too!

The witch: Wait! I want to marry you, prince. Please marry me!

The prince: What nonsense are you talking about? I will not marry you.

The witch: If you do not marry me, I will kill this princess. (Takes the princess and disappears.)

The prince: No! I will not let my princess die! I must do something. (Goes to the God)

The prince: God, you are the only one to help me to get back my princess. Please, help me. She is in the cave.

God: Why are you losing confidence? 'Always be brave, especially in the cave!' Remember these words! (The God disappears.)

The prince: I will do what God says. I will not lose confidence.
(Lights go off. All characters go off stage)

Scene II: In the cave

Setting: In the cave, long time ago

Narrator's Introduction:

The prince went to the cave. He had nothing but he had confidence. He saw the witch.

The prince: Where is my princess?

The witch: Over there! Before she gets free, promise me that you will get marry me.

The prince: Always be brave! Especially in the cave!

The witch: Oh my god! What is happening to me? (The witch dies because that was a magic spell.)

The prince: Oh! My princess. (He takes the princess out.)

The princess: (The princess cries.) You are my hero! Thank you for saving my life! I love you!

The prince: (Happily) I love you too!

(Lights go off. Curtains close. All characters go off stage.)
